Professor Robert Solomon

Professor Solomon is currently on the Faculty of Law at the University of Western Ontario and is the National Director of Legal Policy for Mothers Against Drunk Driving (MADD) Canada. He has been involved in research and teaching on health care, civil liability and criminal law for over 35 years. One of his major areas of recent concern has been the increasingly challenging legal environment facing social workers, nursing home staff, health practitioners and youth workers. He has written extensively on these issues, and is the lead author of A Legal Guide for Social Workers published by the Ontario Association for Social Workers.

Tammy Rankin

Tammy is an inspirational speaker who blends humour and real life examples to help participants look into often disturbing and upsetting topics. Tammy is a graduate of McMaster University and holds a degree in Gerontology and Sociology. She has worked with older adults in a variety of settings, focusing for the last 15 years on long term care. At the end of this presentation, participants will be able to identify community partners necessary to involve and implement practical interventions strategies to assist and support older adults who are abused and identify obstacles to sharing information.
